HABITS AND STATES
Use **used to** + verb to talk about past habits and states.
*Usamos **used to** + verbo para hablar de hábitos y estados pasados.*

	English	Spanish
Affirmative	I used to + verb	Yo solía + verbo
Negative	I didn't use to + verb	Yo no solía + verbo
Interrogative	Did you use to + verb?	¿Solías + verbo ...?

NOTE
library : biblioteca
bookshop: librería

- I **used** to drink a lot of soft drinks when I was a teenager.
- *Yo solía beber muchos refrescos cuando era adolescente.*
- I **didn't use** to wear trendy clothes when I was seven years old.
- *Yo no solía llevar ropa de moda cuando tenía siete años.*
- **Did you use** to be worried about how you looked when you were seven years old?
- *¿Solías preocuparte sobre tu aspecto cuando tenías siete años?*

Past Simple	Present perfect
To talk about finished past actions.	To talk about actions that started in the past and continue or have a result in the present
<i>Para hablar de acciones pasadas acabadas.</i>	<i>Para hablar de acciones que empezaron en el pasado y continúan o tienen un efecto en el presente.</i>
With specific past times: last year, five minutes ago, yesterday...	With unspecific past times.
<i>Con momentos específicos del pasado: el año pasado, hace cinco minutos, ayer...</i>	<i>Con momentos inespecíficos del pasado</i>
- I had a cold <u>last week</u> . - <i>Yo tuve un resfriado la semana pasada.</i>	- Now I have recovered . - <i>Ahora yo me he recuperado.</i>
